

Rezoning Request

From R10 to B3:

Our rezoning request is the cornerstone of our vision for Chugach Crown. It's not just about changing land use; it's about fostering a community that serves all of Anchorage.

Current R10 Zoning

Restrictions

Limited to campgrounds, education centers, and sparse residential development.

Economic Impact

Each vacant land or lot sale could cost upwards of \$1 million per parcel, making it inaccessible to many.

Proposed B3 Zoning

Opportunities

A vibrant mixed-use area with workforce housing, commercial spaces, and both for-sale and for-rent market-rate homes.

Economic Benefits


Lower development costs, increased job creation, and a boost to the local economy.

Environmental Considerations

To align with EPA's upcoming well restrictions, we need project approval by 2023. Without it, we face a \$22 million utility connection cost. Our goal: cost-effective commercial well drilling.

Affordable Housing

Workforce Housing Units

75 units with a rent cap of \$800 per month, all-inclusive. This ensures that those who work in Anchorage can also afford to live in Anchorage.

Diverse Housing Options

Mini Condos

Flexible options for sale or long-term lease, catering to both individuals and small families.

Townhomes

35 units ranging from 1200-1750 sq ft, offering a balance between apartment living and standalone homes.

Homes

25 units ranging from 2100-2700 sq ft, catering to larger families or those desiring more space.

Job Creation


Housing construction and subsequent commercial spaces will create jobs.

Firebreaks


Strategically placed to prevent the spread of wildfires, protecting both our community and the adjacent Chugach State Park.

Helicopter Pad


Positioned to assist with emergencies in both our community and the neighboring state park.


