**NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
RECOMMEND SUPPRESSION**

This Court, having heard testimony, taken evidence, and reviewed the filings, hereby notifies the parties that it intends to recommend granting the Motion to Suppress at Docket No. 320. The record, however, is incomplete as to the scope of suppression.

Accordingly, **IT IS SO ORDERED** that by **April 8, 2026**, the parties shall meet and confer and submit a status report on whether the government would move to dismiss the superseding indictment, and if not, whether the parties can stipulate to the evidence seized from the search warrants and the fruits thereof. Should the parties not come to an agreement, each side shall submit an additional status report by **April 8, 2026** not to exceed ten pages detailing (1) the evidence in dispute; (2) the reason why it should or should not be suppressed; and (3) whether the party requests further evidentiary proceedings. The parties' positions on the merits of the motion shall not be reiterated in these filings.
